- Plan lesson content based on results of student needs assessment
- Plan and deliver lessons that meet the learning objectives of the learner
- Schedule tutoring sessions in conjunction with New Directions and the learner
- Submit monthly activity records
- Attend team and or learner intake meetings when required

- Teaching English as a Second Language Certificate from a TESL Canada certified institution
- Undergraduate degree
- Experience teaching and or tutoring foundations level
- Experience working with adult immigrant learners
- Knowledge of and sensitivity to the settlement process for newcomers
