

Ice Skating Instructor

Job Overview

The purpose of the program is to engage newcomers in one of Winnipeg's integral winter activities and foster a sense of belonging to a new community. It is a program that helps newcomer parents participate in a winter activity with their children, one that is accessible, low cost, healthy and fun. The Skating Instructors assist newcomer adults learn basic skating skills in a fun and welcoming environment. This free of charge program runs from January to March, once per week at Central Park.

Role and Responsibilities

- Welcome pre-registered skaters
- Assist with fitting skates and helmets (all equipment is provided and stored at Knox Church 400 Edmonton Street)
- Provide dry land basics
- Assist skaters to the ice at Central Park
- Provide on ice skills exercises
- Supervise volunteers
- Clean up equipment and ensure it is properly stored
- Conduct regular equipment inventory, equipment upkeep, annual skate sharpening, and equipment purchase when necessary

Qualifications

- Excellent ice skating skills
- Teaching experience, English as an additional language teaching experience preferred
- Ability to communicate effectively with all levels of English in the group.
- Valid First Aid certificate
- Clear Criminal Record Check
